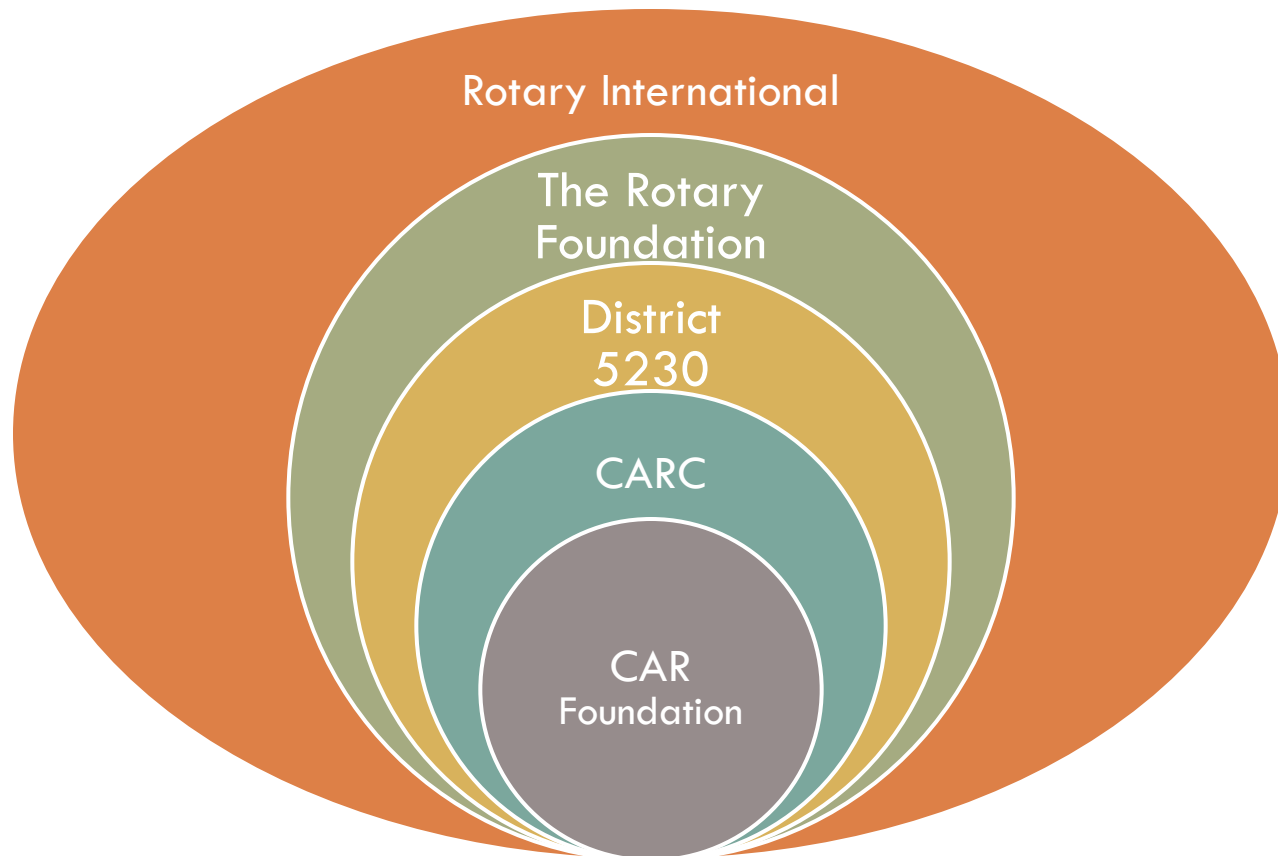

The Foundation is a not-for-profit corporation supported solely by voluntary contributions from Rotarians and friends of the Foundation who share its vision of a better world.

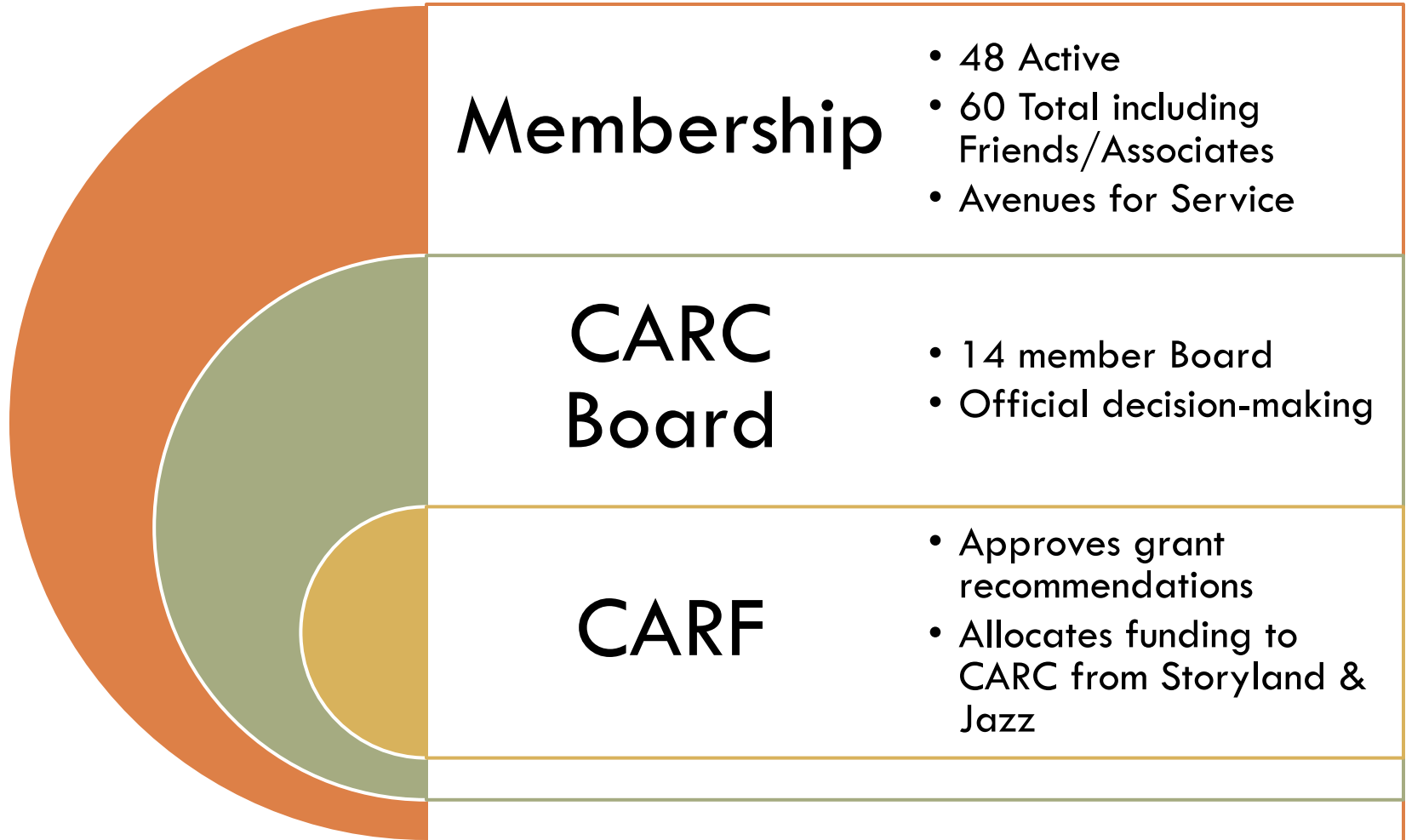


# The Rotary Foundation (TRF)

- Annual Giving by members results in funds to projects at district and club level throughout R.I.
- Paul Harris Fellow - \$1,000 annual gift per year
  - ▣ Can be designated to Annual Fund or other fund categories
  - ▣ Giving \$1,000 to Cultural Arts Rotary Foundation does not result in being a Paul Harris Fellow
- Polio Plus designated fund
- Rotary Peace Centers
- Endowment Fund
  - ▣ Any giving to designated fund does not go to district grants

# Cultural Arts Rotary Foundation

- Purpose: Receive, maintain, manage and distribute gifts of money and/or property solely to or for the benefit of non-profits.
- An “operational foundation” to benefit the club and its efforts
- A 501(c)3 tax-exempt foundation.
  - Gifts to CARF are charitable and may be tax deductible
  - Gifts to CARC (the club) may also be tax deductible



# Cultural Arts Rotary Foundation

- Currently 12 member CARF Board
  - ▣ Anticipate decrease in number named in by-laws
  - ▣ By-laws to be revised
  - ▣ Financial reports to be improved
  - ▣ Approve giving requests recommended by CARC Board
  - ▣ Allocates funds raised from Storyland & Jazz
    - Determines how much available for giving each year
    - CARC Board decides who to give to; CARF approves
  - ▣ \$200,000+ in investments toward long term goal of an Endowment
    - At least 5%/year is provided as gifts/grants





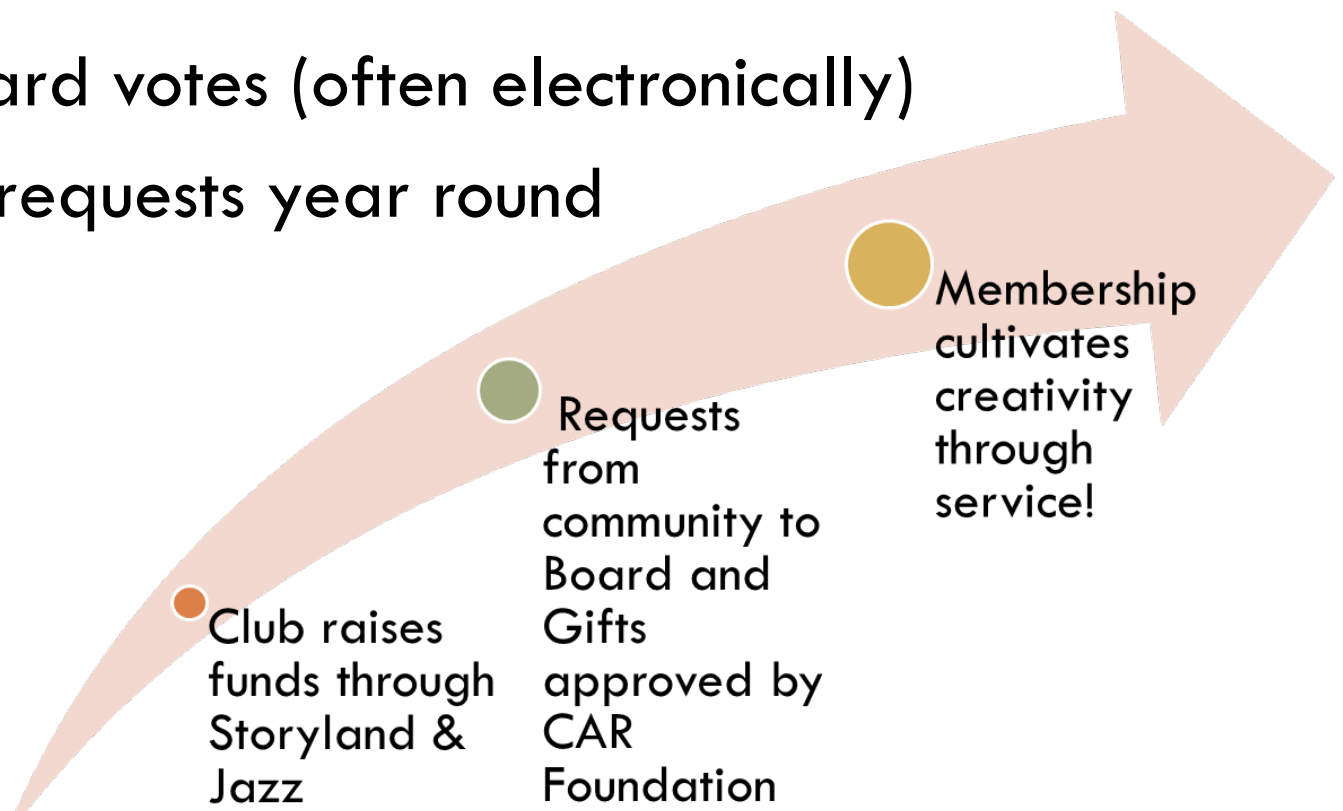
# CARC Giving Process

- Requests of under \$500 go directly to Club Board in written letter
- Requests for \$500 and up have application process
- Applications given preference if oriented to cultural arts and youth
- Application from Mark Smith until posted on new website
  - [smsmithteach@gmail.com](mailto:smsmithteach@gmail.com)
- He and small committee review and send recommendation to CARC Board



# CARC Giving Process

- CARC Board reviews recommendation and application
- CARC makes own recommendation to CARF Board
- CARF Board votes (often electronically)
- Open to requests year round
